Comenius orchard is a big park behind the New town hall. Through park flows river called Ostravice.


Ostrava Zoological Garden and Botanical Park

The Ostrava Zoo is the second largest in the republic with its area of 100 hectares, there are more than 3500+ animals and about 400 different species. Its music festival focused on electronic music.

It is held annually in Ostrava, on the territory of the industrial monument Lower area Vítkovice for 4 days.

Beskydy

It is located in the Czech Republic, Poland and Slovakia.

Forested middle mountains form smaller mountains:

Moravian-Silesian Beskydy, Silesian Beskydy, Kysucké Beskydy and Orava Beskydy.

The highest mountain in the Beskydy Mountains is Babia hora. The Moravian Beskydy Mountains have been a part of the Beskydy Protected Landscape Area since 1973



Sněžka

The Sněžka is highest mountain of Czech Republic. It lies in the Krkonoše (1603.3 m above sea level) On top of the Sněžka is border between Czech Republic and Poland. You will also find a meteorological station, the Chapel of St. Vavřince and the Cable car.

Real top of the Sněžka is on Poland side and it is 10 cm higher than our top.

There are above 10 000 tourists per day.



Karlštejn

Karlštejn is the most famous castle in the Czech republic

It is located about 30 kilometres southwest of Prague in the Beroun District of the Central Bohemian Region

This large gothic castle was founded in 1348 by Charles IV.

The castle served as a place for safekeeping the Imperial Regalia



Aquapalace Prague

- Occupies area bigger than 9000 square meters
- It is the largest water park in Central Europe
- Also includes fitness centre, spa & wellness and over 14 different types of saunas
- In the Water World, there are lots of attractions, for example, multiple slides (One of them is the longest in our country), artificial waves and also spacebowl
